
Removal of Personal Belief/Religious Exemptions Have Contributed to Enrollment Decline



From 2015/16 to 20222/23 Enrollment has decreased by 364,508. In 2021–22 alone, there was a decrease of more than 110,000 students. This follows a steady decline in public school enrollment statewide since 2014–15. https://www.cde.ca.gov/nr/ne/yr22/yr22rel20.asp
