"Notwithstanding Sections 120325 and 120335, any immunizations deemed appropriate by the department pursuant to paragraph (11) of subdivision (a) of Section 120325 or paragraph (11) of subdivision (b) of Section 120335, may be mandated before a pupil's first admission to any private or public elementary or secondary school, child care center, day nursery, nursery school, family day care home, or development center, only if exemptions are allowed for both medical reasons and personal beliefs."

Emergency Use Authorization Notice to California School

This letter will also serve as notice that the following Covid-19 bodily intrusions are Emergency Use Authorization (EUA): Covid-19 vaccination, Covid-19 testing, and Covid-19 face coverings.

For a child under age 16, and also for everyone where Comirnaty is unavailable, COVID-19 vaccines are authorized for emergency use only. And the Federal law governing such authorization, 21 U.S.C. § 360bbb-3(e)(1)(A)(ii)(I-III), grants the individual explicitly "the option to accept or refuse administration of the [EUA] product." Every FDA fact sheet for an EUA COVID-19 vaccine states the same disclaimer, "It is your choice to receive or not receive the [Pfizer-BioNTech, Moderna, Janssen] COVID-19 Vaccine."

Notably, COVID-19 tests and face coverings are also EUA only. See e.g., https://www.fda.gov/media/137121/download (face covering EUA); https://www.fda.gov/media/136598/download (PCR test EUA).

Thus, they too should not be mandated. The FDA states, "In an emergency, it is critical that the conditions that are part of the EUA ... be strictly followed, and that no additional conditions be imposed." https://www.fda.gov/media/97321/download.
